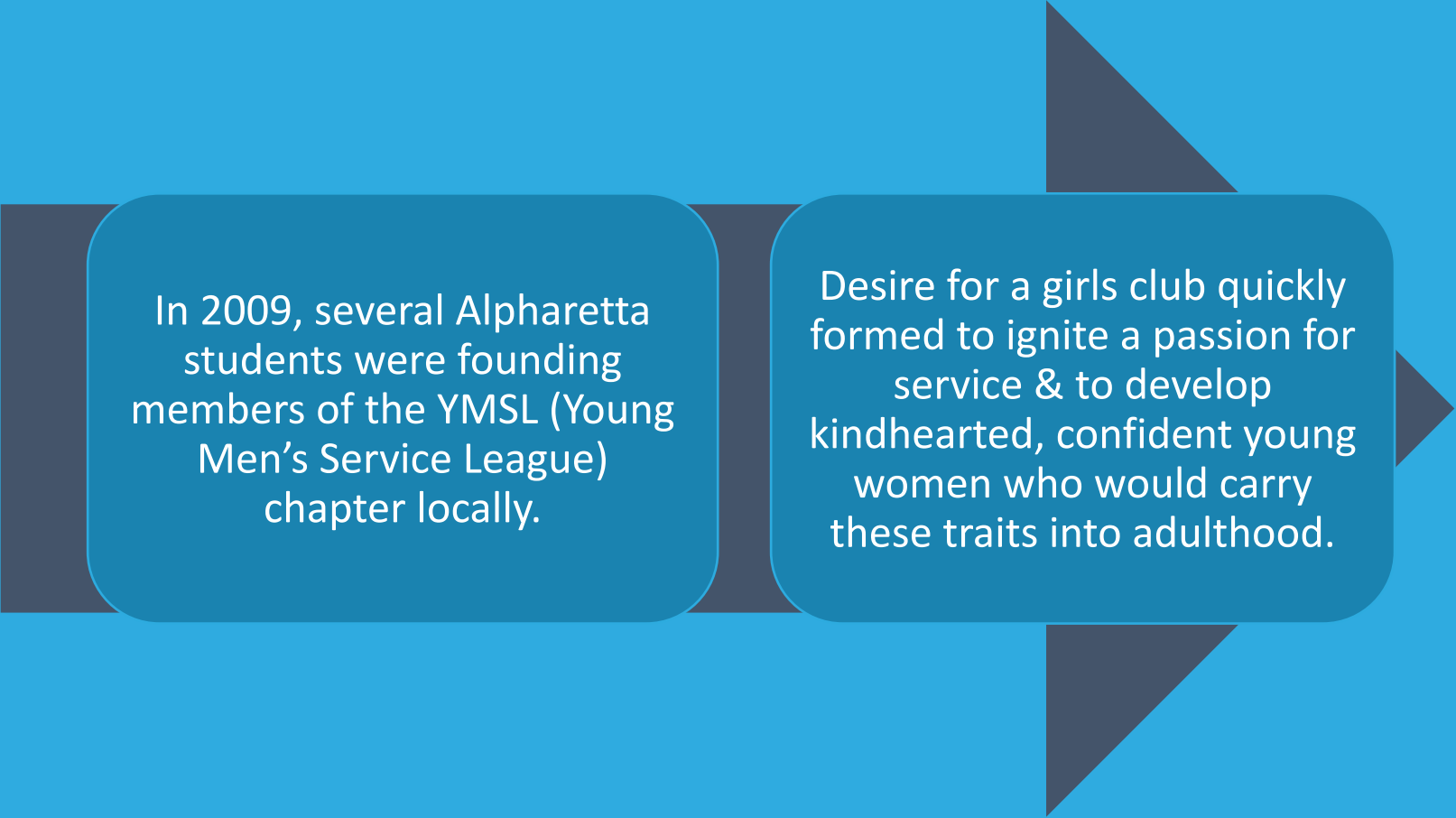
CATS is...

Annual Membership Requirements

- No more than 5 of the 15 CATS hours can come from donations to CATS philanthropies.

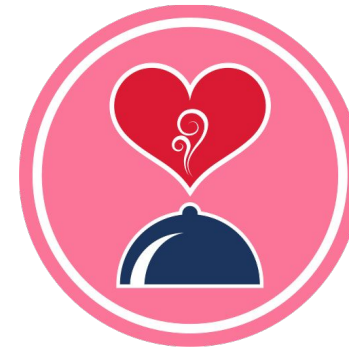

Earning a CATS Cord for Graduation

Must complete 80 hours of service across the time they have been a CATS member

Up to 20 CATS donation hours total over your four years (versus service hours) may count towards your 80 total hours

New to CATS as an upperclassman? No problem, **but you are still required to complete 80 hours by Feb. 28th of your senior year.**

Hours must be completed and logged into MobileServe prior to Feb 28th of your senior year.

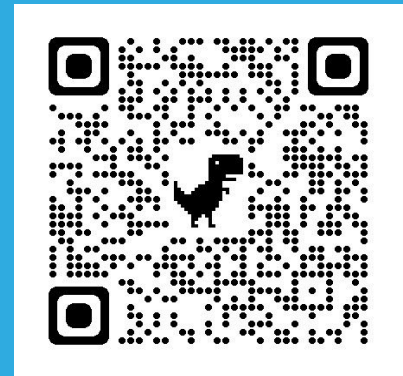
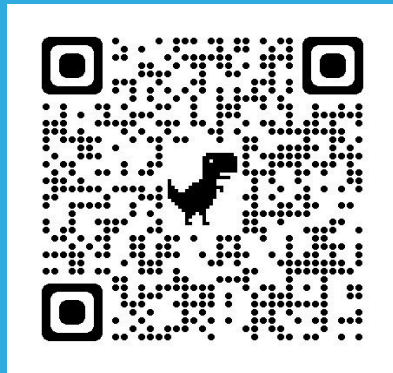
