Annual Membership Requirements

All members are required to perform 20 hours of service per membership year	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 15 hours must be done with CATS philanthropies• No more than 5 of the 15 CATS hours can come from donations to CATS philanthropies.
Calendar for service: Aug 1-July 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All hours must be submitted by August 15th• SENIOR hours must be submitted no later than February 28th
Register and Pay Annual Dues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Register• Annual Dues: \$40

If you sign up to volunteer and cannot attend, please cancel 48 hours in advance by contacting the philanthropy chair

No shows are unacceptable

Wear CATS T-shirt while completing service hours

CATS Senior Service Cord Requirements

Complete 80 hours of service across the time they have been a CATS member

20 service hours per year (a minimum of 15 hours with CATS partner philanthropies)

A maximum of 5 donation hours with CATS partner philanthropies per year can be substituted for service hours

Submit service hours by Feb 28th of your senior year

New to CATS as an upperclassman? No problem, but you are still required to submit 80 hours by Feb 28th of your senior year
